<p>Draft concluding document:</p> <p>Elements to be prepared by a working group chaired by the conveners at the next Glion meeting.</p>	<p>The document should clearly refer to the NPT 1995 Resolution on the Middle East, and the 2010 NPT Review Conference Middle East Action Plan as a basis for holding the Conference. It should also define and adopt the process that will follow the Conference, and draw a detailed Road Map for the obligations and commitments of all the participating States.</p>
<p>Date for the Helsinki Conference:</p> <p>The Goal for the next Glion meeting is to achieve agreement among the regional parties on the arrangements for the Conference so that the conveners can propose a date for the Conference to be held in the first half of 2014.</p>	<p>The Goal for the next Glion meeting is to achieve agreement among the regional parties on the arrangements for the Conference so that the conveners can fix and declare a date to hold the Conference.</p>
