**ISRAELI NUCLEAR CAPABILITIES
AND THREAT**

The General Conference agreed to the following statement made by the President:

"The President said that his extensive consultations with various groups and delegations over the past few days had revealed a general feeling among delegations that, in view of the peace process already under way in the Middle East, the aim of which was to conclude a comprehensive and just peace in the region, and which included in particular discussions on the establishment of a nuclear-weapon-free zone in the Middle East, it would be desirable not to consider the present agenda item at the thirty-sixth regular session. In the absence of any objection, he would take that to be the view of the General Conference."
