Establishment of a working committee to continue deliberations among members of the Conference on the Establishment of a Middle East Zone Free of Nuclear Weapons and Other Weapons of Mass Destruction during the intersessional period of the Conference

The Conference on the Establishment of a Middle East Zone Free of Nuclear Weapons and Other Weapons of Mass Destruction decides:

(a) To establish, on an informal basis, in accordance with the rules of procedure of the Conference, a working committee, open to all members of the Conference, to continue deliberations during the period between annual sessions of the Conference on issues related to the mandate of the Conference, as contained in General Assembly decision 73/546 of 22 December 2018, on the basis of the outcomes of each annual session of the Conference;

(b) That the working committee will be convened by the President of the Conference, with the support of the secretariat of the Conference, and will hold a minimum of two meetings during each intersessional period;

(c) That the working committee may decide to invite observers and experts to contribute to its work;

(d) That the working committee may decide to report on its work to the Conference at its subsequent annual session.
